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APPLIED META-PHYSICS, THE SCIENCE OF BE-ING AND KNOWING

ESSAY: CONVERSION

Conversion is a word which is so often used and so little understood. We hear people say they ‘converted’ from ‘this religion’ to ‘that religion’ and all the mayhem that goes with it, the breaking up of families and relationships, and all the emotional turmoil involved.

When I started another series of essays a few years ago, a friend asked me if I could write using a frame of reference for another ‘faith’ and I explained that Truth is Truth, and that a school of thought interpreting Truth is not the Truth. That the Truth lives within each of us, and when we know and understand the Truth it sets us free from the idea of division and of ‘different faiths’.

What the world calls ‘faith’, by and large is a conversion of Truth into a local language and vocabulary, which is supposed to make it easier to assimilate, yet, due to the dark forces capturing the mind, creates division, disagreements, confusion, dis-ease, wars and all the suffering following in their path.

Everyone agrees we should be able to live free



of these things, and many can visualise a much kinder, peaceful world, in their minds.

The challenge facing us is one of ‘conversion’.

This is such an important topic. Last night as I was meditating on what topic to write about in today’s essay, I was transported to a room, a bare room, without any furnishings, and there was someone with me in the room. After a brief discussion we decided to measure the room. He was not identified, and we looked around and we chose a recess in a corner of the room to start to measure.

Neither of us had a tape measure. So, under these circumstances, experienced designers will ‘pace out’ distances to get an idea of the dimensions.

The recess had panels at the back along the wall and we used their approximate dimensions as a gauge to measure between the right and left sides of the recess.

We agreed the distance was approximately 10.5m and I estimated it was about 900mm deep. I did not feel comfortable with guessing, so I said “there must be a tape measure here somewhere.” I went into the next room, there was a drawer with some tools and a tape measure turned face down. I picked up the tape measure, which looked smaller than we’d need for the long walls and thought “we can make this work”.



Then I took it next door and I measured from the recess to the door... it was 105 INCHES. The tape measure I had picked up, and had not seen the label, was marked out in inches.

It was then I realised I'd need to measure up, then convert everything I measured into meters and millimetres, which I AM much more familiar with.

As soon as I had made this decision, the vision was over. Immediately I understood the message, and what is the topic of today's essay.

The room had specific dimensions. It had walls and windows and doors and recesses, each FIXED and representing an aspect of the space to be measured, and all together comprised of an entity we all would agree is a 'room'.

The room represents the World, it represents the Cosmos *as it is*. The uni-verse, the One Song of God, *as it is*.

We are all familiar with these terms. Although in using the words every day, or even when thinking about the concepts, perhaps we are not considering the *depths* of their meaning.

It is likely that many are not, simply because of the 'schooling' we have all passed through which emphasised 'intellectualism', which is a dis-ease. It is the dis-ease or un-ease, or ***im-balance***, created by developing one branch or

faculty of consciousness, *to the detriment of the others.*

This intellectualism is like measuring the distance of the recess in meters, and then telling someone who works in inches, and who has never heard of meters and millimetres to build a cabinet, while preventing them from measuring the recess itself.

ALTHOUGH it is the exact same recess to be furnished, the TRUTH has been confused in the minds of those involved, by a system of measurement; by a frame of reference.

In order for a tight fitting cabinet to be made, there must be a *conversion* of the information ***passed from the person measuring, to the person fabricating*** from meters into feet and inches. *The space must be comprehensible to the person building the cabinets.*

This is a simple example, which represents the countless forms of conversion we all participate in every day. As I write these words, I AM converting an intuitive impulse into ideas, then thinking about them and then writing them down. The inner process happens so quickly, it can be said to be a timeless experience. And it is.

The reality is that the essence of our Life is *timeless*, the life impulse is transmitted through the various brain centres of our bodies, into impulses and becomes thinking and behaviour. Before this process, it is a complete idea existing on the spiritual plane.



Although we are all the product of trillions of acts of conversion every minute, the intellect, in its limitations prevents the full comprehension of these processes and, worse, it tries to make everything subject to its decisions and its own frame of reference.

This is the 'Satanic' aspect of the Race Thought Atmosphere, permeating peoples minds, hijacking them and limiting them severely.

The 'Satanism' is the magnifying of the 'differences' rather than recognising the similarities. Differences 'divide' people, similarities and frames of reference are just that, a basis for observing and understanding relationships and the underlying Truth, which unites us all. Exactly the same as the purpose of each organ of the body is to serve the whole.

Another example is a motor car, an 'automobile' with a fixed roof. A fixed roof represents the intellect and its fixed perceptions, and a 'convertible', that is, a car with a roof which opens, represents being open to universal perspectives and perceptions.

The one driving the convertible will need to work hard to find words to describe the view to the one inside the fixed roof vehicle. Even then, the description will never be adequate, only when the driver experiences the open top, will *they really know and understand*.



In terms of meta-physics, the room is our world, we are all measuring the world, we are setting up frames of reference and each individual, or group is claiming their *measurement* is 'the truth' when the real Truth is the room itself. ***The Truth is the idea of an enclosed space, made manifest:*** the room.

The room is—and whether we measure in meters or inches or hands or cubits, arm span, pace or foot span, ***it is still the same room.*** For *conversion* to ***serve us***, we need to be prepared to make ***constant adjustments.*** As you read, you are receiving in-formation, and constantly converting it into a format you are familiar with. To illustrate the process of conversion, consider this 'HINDOO' (sic) Fable/Parable:

THE BLIND MEN AND THE ELEPHANT. A HINDOO FABLE.

1. IT was six men of Indostan
To learning much inclined,
Who went to see the Elephant
(Though all of them were blind),
That each by observation
Might satisfy his mind.
2. The First approached the Elephant,
And happening to fall
Against his broad and sturdy side,
At once began to bawl:
"God bless me!—but the Elephant
Is very like a wall!"



3. The Second, feeling of the tusk,
Cried: "Ho!—what have we here
So very round and smooth and sharp?
To me 't is mighty clear
This wonder of an Elephant
Is very like a spear!"
4. The Third approached the animal,
And happening to take
The squirming trunk within his hands,
Thus boldly up and spake:
"I see," quoth he, "the Elephant
Is very like a snake!"
5. The Fourth reached out his eager hand,
And felt about the knee.
"What most this wondrous beast is like
Is mighty plain," quoth he;
"'T is clear enough the Elephant
Is very like a tree!"
6. The Fifth, who chanced to touch the ear,
Said: "E'en the blindest man
Can tell what this resembles most;
Deny the fact who can,
This marvel of an Elephant
Is very like a fan!"
7. The Sixth no sooner had begun
About the beast to grope,
Than, seizing on the swinging tail
That fell within his scope,
"I see," quoth he, "the Elephant
Is very like a rope!"
8. And so these men of Indostan
Disputed loud and long,
Each in his own opinion



Exceeding stiff and strong,
Though each was partly in the right,
And all were in the wrong!

MORAL

So, oft in theologic wars
The disputants, I ween,
Rail on in utter ignorance
Of what each other mean,
And prate about an Elephant
Not one of them has seen!

This fable came to mind, and serves as an illustration, and although it is well known, even those who claim to know it, still cling to a part of the animal! I.E. They cling to the measure they've used for truth and each expects the others to comprehend them.

The ONLY way out of this situation, is to recognise the language each clothes the truth, in and remain aware of the Truth, which, although all around us, is projected from within us. Harmony prevails when we each recognise each other as embodying an aspect of the whole—Truth.

Each of these six men from 'Indostan' can be likened to the faculties we use each day; the five senses and the intellect, all claiming vehemently that their limited perception of truth, is the WHOLE Truth, when what they share inhibits rather than liberates.



The purpose of Religion is to unite the fragmentations of the mind, unite them and in this way change perception...and to do so it reveals to us faculties, within us, which are far superior and necessary for us to see and perceive the world as it is... not as it appears to the limited senses.

Since the days of the Sanskrit writings, wise people have known of our immortal nature, our essence, our blueprint. They have taught that our purpose is to overcome the cycle of birth and death, and no longer need to incarnate.

Many people have converted this teaching into their own format, claiming that it has meant that we die and go to a far away heaven, or reincarnate to work off 'Karma' or exist in a heavenly realm

What Applied Meta-Physics teaches and what Science is revealing is that the omni-present field of energy are one and the same. **There is no division, the 'material' and spiritual world IS ONE.** That which animates us right now rests in the Spiritual plane where there is no time.

Our Spiritual essence is incrementally flowing into this body, converting it, from the idea of a dense 'flesh and blood' 'meat suit' (as some
