APPLIED META-PHYSICS, THE SCIENCE OF BE-ING AND KNOWING

ESSAY: UNDERSTANDING PHILOSOPHY

There's mass delusion regarding the word 'philosophy' and its meaning. It has been diluted and corrupted beyond recognition and its original meaning has been deeply buried in error.

The word *philosopher* means a 'lover of wisdom', and to understand the real meaning of the term 'lover of wisdom', one must know and understand what 'wisdom' is, and where it comes from, and the role it has in our lives.

A philosopher is one who lives and cleaves to the Divine Wisdom (worldly 'wisdom' or intellectual cleverness pales in comparison) despite the protestations of 'worldly wisdom', 'scientific knowledge' and 'intellectual cleverness'.

One who is a true philosopher can also be described as a Gnostic.

To understand the term Gnostic, one also must understand the term 'faith'. The word 'faith' is yet another word which has been contorted and corrupted so that its real meaning has been buried in error and pure deceit.



Page: 3 of: 19 www.servadei.com Faith is translated from 'Pistis' and Pistis is the ability to still the lower 666 (carnal mind/mind of the beast/lower mind) and enter into the Higher Mind (the 888 mind of Jesus/I AM) and perceive the Spiritual world all around us, in which this world is nested.

This 'material' world is the product of an eternal Spiritual world, and this world takes shape through us, according to what we perceive of the higher Spiritual world.

To still the carnal mind / the 'beast' within us, takes concerted effort. When we still the lower mind, we experience the higher vibrations of love and wisdom, which transport us into the Higher vibrational planes. It is here that we gain FAITH. As there is only ONE Spiritual world, there is only ONE FAITH.

Faith has come to mean 'blind belief' or 'believing without experiencing' or 'believing without knowing' or 'believing because you were told' or 'being a part of a sect, called 'a faith' and other totally erroneous definitions which lead people astray and make them two-fold a child of hell. "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

So, the 'faith' of 'just believe' of the 'churches' does not guide us consciously in the process of







ReGeneration, and Salvation.

Faith is earned when a person individually and sincerely silences the carnal mind and enters into the spiritual world and gains faith for her/himself.

To have Faith is to KNOW GOD/God-Self, and be in communion with the Higher (888) mind, and participate in taking up one's cross (the 777 plane of consciousness) and is busy overcoming the 666 plane of consciousness and is putting on abundant life, where sickness, disease and death are no more.

This is the whole teaching of the Gospel in a nutshell: To attain Spiritual consciousness, overcome death, here and now, and in passing through the Door of the Law/Jesus/I AM, enter into atonement with God and attain conscious immortality.

What has this to do with 'philosophy'?

A Philosopher is one who has faith, having passed over the carnal mind, entered via the higher mind, into the Spiritual world and it is revealed to them in the shape of forthcoming events, inventions, and premonitions, etc.

A part of this journey (which is in pure stillness) is a passing from the material consciousness into the Spiritual consciousness through the 'veil of forgetting'.







The veil of forgetting is the veil between this world and the omnipresent Spiritual world. When, in the absolute stillness of meditation, we pass out of this body consciousness, we 'forget' it. That is, we are not identified with the body, although we know we have a body.

In this altered state of the 777/888 higher planes of consciousness, we are GUIDED through the spiritual world by the highest plane of consciousness: God. What we learn is specific to each person, and has the purpose of guiding, reassuring, and teaching each of us, what we need to know in the process of salvation.

This revelation is then called Knowing/Gnosis, and when we come back through the veil, onto this plane of consciousness we are then Gnostics' having experienced the Spiritual plane and communed with it. Gnosis is what we retain in personal experience and knowledge, when we return to this 'material' plane.

When one has received this education through faith, and is centred in the I AM, (Jesus) and become a Gnostic (knower) the spiritual outpouring accompanying the union with the Spiritual world (the opening of the Spiritual umbilical cord, the Kundalini/Baptism of the Holy Spirit) floods the sensual plane of mind the 333, and the desire plane of mind, the 555 consciousness, cleansing them from sin.







That is, the Spirit illumines the intellect revealing the higher planes of consciousness. And pouring Spiritual power through the other planes to cleanse them.

The 444 plane is the Serpent coil/DNA energy pent up within us, and when this energy is released we experience a state of Grace and Love, which casts out all fear and starts the biological regeneration, which shall culminate in everlasting life.

"I (Jesus/I AM) come that you may have life, and have it abundantly". - Jesus

Remember the name 'Jesus Christ' means "I AM FILLED WITH LIFE, LIGHT AND POW-ER". 'Jesus' is I AM, and 'Christ' being the anointing of the life, light and power of God, which works within us to heal every dis-ease.

So, having passed into the Spiritual world, learned from it, gained faith, we learn:

"Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen". Hebrews 11:1

And this 'substance' is the vision one receives through the faculty of the imagination, and the perception of it via the faculty of faith, so this 'evidence' is what has already *been seen on the inner planes*, in the Spiritual World in which this world is nested.







Faith is made manifest through works, as an architect 'sees' a building in his mind and then works out the steps to make it manifest. So, this is an aspect of philosophy, as we receive on the inner, what we are going to profess in the world of appearances

"The air is thick with God", yet those who are carnally minded, although they receive the gift of life from the spiritual planes, do not acknowledge their source, so they remain in 'outer darkness'. The 'outer darkness' is being ignorant of the absolute beauty, *light and power contained within one's own heart*.

To have 'faith' is to live in both worlds, the Spiritual and the 'material' worlds simultaneously, drawing inspiration from the spiritual world daily, and becoming a Gnostic, that is, someone *who knows* what to do in this world because they have been educated in the Spiritual world.

This *faith* (Pistis) and *knowing* (Gnosis) is our personal experience. No one can give it to us, and, no one can take it away from those who have received it. It can be taken away no more than the lunch you had yesterday can be taken away.

As the Spiritual world is omnipresent, one can enter into it at any time and in any place. When one becomes an adept, one is constantly living in 'both worlds' knowing them as ONE.







This is where we get the word Wisdom from, translated from 'Sophia'. Wisdom is the ability to constantly live by the teaching one has received on the inner planes. Wisdom/Sophia is knowing what to do, *and when to do it*, on this material plane. To have the ability and courage to live by Sophia's guidance despite the opinions of others, is to become a Lover of Wisdom, a Philosopher.

So, philosophy is not the blind grasping after knowledge or a set of 'beliefs' that modern translations have deceived people into thinking it is, with a multitude of 'philosophies' and big words, which cause the seeker to go around in circles in the outer darkness of this material world. Becoming a philosopher is the tangible result of maturing into Spiritual consciousness, binding back (religare/religion) the two worlds of 'material' manifestation and Spiritual source, and the working out of our salvation, towards the attainment of everlasting life.

Seeing into the omnipresent Spiritual world is exactly how the prophets came to know what was going to happen on this plane of consciousness, the earth, the 333 sensual plane, where we connect with the earth via the senses.

When one lives by Faith (Pistis) and has communed with the Spirit World (Gnosis) and *lives* by it on the material plane expressing







Wisdom (Sophia) one has become a philosopher: *A Lover of Wisdom*.

Now, the material world has its ways, the Race Thought Atmosphere and its influences restricting spiritual expression, and, the Spiritual World has its principles, which are et-ernal.

When one lives according to Faith, one has awakened within oneself and knows first hand, and lives by what is revealed to them on the inner planes despite the traditions of the world. It is then, that one has become a Philosopher. That is, one who cleaves to God despite the protestations, the rules and regulations of the material world.

To live as a Philosopher (which is a description, not a title), is to wrestle with oneself, and pass through the Door of the Divine Law, and to receive the blessing of Pistis-Gnosis-Sophia, commonly known as Pistis-Sophia, which is consciousness of everlasting life.

Our body, is our book of life. It is a complete record of everything we receive on the inner, everything we eat, drink, speak, do and experience.

Everything is written into our body, which no one can hide from everyone around us. Our body is self-perpetuating and self-renewing, self-healing, and is either degenerating if we are not in alignment with the Law, or ReGen-







erating when we are in alignment with the Law. It contains all the elements necessary for total regeneration and the attainment of everlasting life.

Our body is also a door.

It is the door from the Spiritual to the material and from the material to the spiritual. Our mind is a bi-directional prism, and our body is shaped by our minds.

"Be ye transformed (healed) by the renewing of your minds".

We live expressing the Spiritual power animating us, and we also assimilate what those before us have expressed and assimilated which appears all around us as the world of appearances.

If we are in an acquisitive frame of mind to the detriment of the spiritual, we commit suicide. When we recognise the Spirit as the source of life and we express it, we regenerate the body, heal it, strengthen it and it is renewed and restored into "the image AFTER the likeness of God".

A Philosopher has consciously merged the two worlds within her/himself, and draws on the Spiritual power to heal and to draw forth from the great storehouse of being, everything needed on this plane for a beautiful and joyful







life:

"Seek first the Kingdom of God, and all else will be added unto you..."

So, the attainment of Faith and Wisdom can be summed up in the two Divine statements, which are like the pillars of the Doorway to Everlasting Life:

Love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, soul, mind and strength.

Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

These two 'commands', as well as the other eight, are in-structions, building up the awareness of consciousness of everlasting life.

To live them is to know God and to be divinely guided and protected every moment of every day, as one lives by the Law of Spirit, which is the ONLY law in existence.

By living in alignment with these Laws the doorway to everlasting life remains open and despite the protestations of the carnal mind, we receive the strength to persevere and overcome it.

When we participate in the process of 'religion', of 'religare', that is binding back consciousness of the Spiritual world with the Material world, and *the two become one*, we







have attained "the peace which passes understanding" and which no one can take from us.

We have restored the centre of volition and sovereignty to ourselves and the spiritual outpourings continue until every last carnal idea rooted in the mind is dissolved.

Self-control is the ultimate freedom, where we are no longer subject to the carnal demands of our own minds, or those of 'other people', who are really the word made flesh manifesting as the world's population.

One applies this Pistis-Sophia as one matures into consciousness and becomes steadfast, until the light of the Urim and Thummim of God, are rekindled and burning within us, dissolving all materialistic desires and leading us into full consciousness of the Kingdom of God, here and now.

The result is love of God and of neighbour and the key to draw forth from the eternal storeroom everything required for a peaceful and happy life.

A Philosopher lives 'righteously' that is 'right' according to the Divine Law, and 'wisely' because they have submitted themselves to knowing God and being enabled to see all life as a clearly, endowed with the Wisdom to overcome ignorance and experience life as a wonder-filled gift.







This does not mean we live painlessly in the beginning. It does mean we will have the strength to endure the pain and will mature through it. Pain has the purpose of awakening us to the greater spiritual reality we all have within us, which animates us.

Life is a process of "making the 2 into 1", which means we are merging the Spiritual world, which is the source of this world, with it. In this process we are regenerating and attaining consciousness of everlasting life.

The most important thing we can 'own' is ourselves, our NAME. The name sums up the essence of a thing and gives guidance, strength, information, it in-structs us, it builds us up from within, This is why neophytes, on opening the Kundalini/ being Baptised by the Spirit, chose a *new name*, one which they chose themselves after it was revealed to them by their own Spirit.

"To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it."

Philosophy is the expounding of Wisdom to the World and cleaving to God, living by the Wisdom revealed in the process of working out our Salvation, and salvation is preservation by being flooded with the Holy Spirit/Grace.







When the materialistic thinker resorts to violence, they have submitted to the satanic forces, which create the delusion of division, and in this way they are forfeiting their part in the ReGeneration and this is suicide.

When we receive the impulse of the Spirit and live by it, regardless of the resistance of those materially minded, we have become a lover of Wisdom, a *Philosopher* and the higher teaching in the Gospels are made plain to us and become our daily guide and the Spirit is our protector.

The Beatitudes reveal to the adept initiate what they need to know. As we evolve into awareness and dedicate ourselves to Spiritual growth / the development and perfecting of Character it is the Spirit within us which does the work.

"...My Father worketh hitherto, and I work".

Be still, seek the inner flow of Spirit and it shall be your guide.

"And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;..."

And this is the elimination of the veil between the 'material' and the Spiritual world. Where the two become one.







Understanding Philosophy is to walk in the light of the knowledge of Spirit, and that the Wisdom shared benefits *everyone equally*, and is for our common salvation.

To be a Philosopher is to walk in Spiritual consciousness and be the light one seeks.

ALL the sacred scriptures which are true and contain instructions relating to our salvation were written by those who had passed through the veil, been educated, retained knowledge on coming 'back' and learned how to live by it and share their Wisdom.

They were philosophers.

Lovers of Wisdom in its highest sense.
